ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

COMES NOW, the Petitioner, Department of Professional Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner", and files this Administrative Complaint before the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, and Mental Health Counseling, against, Collin M. Babcock, hereinafter referred to as "Respondent", and alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of clinical social work pursuant to Section 20.30, Chapter 455, and Chapter 491, Florida Statutes.

2. Respondent is, and has been at all times material hereto, a licensed clinical social worker, license number SW 1570, whose address of record is 170 Roosevelt #2, Sarasota, FL 34236.

3. On or about December 31, 1988, a Final Order was issued by the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, and Mental Health Counseling regarding the Respondent's case number 0093849.



4. The Final Order stated the Respondent would be on probation for one year and be supervised by another licensed clinical social worker.


5. The Respondent ceased practicing clinical social work and did not comply with the Final Order of the Board.

6. Based on the foregoing, the Respondent is in violation of Section 491.009(2)(u), Florida Statutes, by violating a rule relating to the regulation of the profession or a lawful order of the Department or the Board previously entered in a disciplinary hearing.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy, and Mental Health Counseling to enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties: Revocation or suspension of the Respondent's practice, imposition of an administrative fine, and/or any other relief which the Board deems appropriate.





FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy and Mental Health Counseling at a public meeting on August 24, 1990, in Jacksonville, Florida. Pursuant to Administrative Complaint, it was alleged that Respondent violated specific sections of Chapter 491, Florida Statutes. Service of the Administrative Complaint was effected by publication. Because Respondent did not respond to the allegations in the Administrative Complaint and was not present at the proceedings, the hearing was conducted in accordance with Section 120.57(2), Florida Statutes. Evidence regarding the Administrative Complaint was received from Petitioner only.

Upon consideration, it is ORDERED:

1. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the findings of fact by the Board.

2. The conclusions of law alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the conclusions of law by the Board.

3. The violations set forth warrant disciplinary action by the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy and Mental Health Counseling pursuant to Section 491.009, Florida Statutes.

THEREFORE,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:
