CLOSING ORDER



THE COMPLAINT: Holding oneself out as a mental health counselor without proper licensure.

THE FACTS: The Dade County Board of Public Instruction contacted the State Attorneys Office regarding Subject who had represented himself as the President of Intensive Counselling Service, Inc. of Florida and who was hired by the County for Counselling Service from January of 1984 to August of 1984 at Miami Killigan High School. Subject was terminated from his employment due to questions regarding his previous criminal charges and past record. Subject then disappeared. The State Attorney's Office and the Department have been unable to locate Subject. The State Attorneys Office will notify us should Subject be located.

THE LAW: Although it appears that Subject may be in violation of the Psychological Service Act, his unlicensed activity has ceased and he cannot be located. Accordingly, this case will be closed and a copy will be forwarded to the Board of Psychological Services for information should Subject seek licensure in the future.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this case should be, and the same is hereby DISMISSED.
