CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleged subject of the investigation failed to appropriately treat two patients, attempting to exploit them and a third party for financial gain.

THE FACTS: Investigation substantiated the allegations. Subject cannot be located, however, and other pending administrative complaints are now before the Board. It is expected that the Board will revoke the physician's license, and further prosecution on these allegations is unnecessary.

THE LAW: Based upon the foregoing, there is sufficient probable cause to believe that an actionable violation of Chapter 458, Florida Statutes, or the rules promulgated thereunder has occurred. However, cause for further prosecution does not exist at this time. Should the physician retain or regain his license to practice medicine, the matter will be reopened.

It is, therefore, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the foregoing matter be, and the same is hereby, dismissed.
