CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Alleges violation Section 490.009(2)(b), (1)(p)(r) and (s) Florida Statutes, by sexual misconduct, fraudulent representation, failing to meet minimum standards of performance, and being unable to practice with reasonable skill and safety.

THE FACTS: This case was previously closed by the Department of Professional Regulation due to the Complainant's unwillingness to cooperate in investigation and prosecution of this matter. The Complainant has explained his prior reluctance and expressed a desire to pursue the case. In addition, new information by way of Subject's admission in deposition, have led the Department to reopen the matte under case number 89-002982.

THE LAW: There is probable cause to believe that the Subject has violated Chapter 490, Florida Statutes. However, for the reasons stated above, this case will be CLOSED.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that the complaint be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
