CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complaint alleges that the Subject violated Section 490.012(1)(a), Florida Statutes, by holding one's self out as a psychologist without possessing a valid, active license to do so.

THE FACTS: The investigation substantiated the claim. The Complainant alleged the Subject identified herself as a psychologist while not holding valid licensure to do so. An evaluation was found in which the Subject was identified as a psychologist.


When contacted, the Subject denied the allegations. She stated her secretary submitted the report identifying her as a psychologist. However, further investigations revealed the Subject has been performing psychological evaluations.

The Subject signed a Cease and Desist Agreement.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, probable cause does exist to believe that the Subject violated Chapter 490, Florida Statutes. However, this case will be closed in that a Cease and Desist Agreement has been signed by the Subject.

It is therefore, ORDERED that the complaint be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
