CLOSING ORDER

**THE COMPLAINT:** Complaint alleges that the Subject violated Section 491.009(2)(a) and 491.009(2)(i), Florida Statutes, by obtaining a license by fraudulent misrepresentation and willfully making or filing a false report or record.

**THE FACTS:** The Department of Professional Regulation received a complaint from the Board of Clinical Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy and Mental Health Counseling which alleged that the Subject had falsified information in his application for licensure. Upon review of the case it appears language used on the application may have been confusing to the Subject. Therefore, the Subject is being sent a Letter of Guidance in lieu of further prosecution.

**THE LAW:** Based on the foregoing, probable cause does exist to believe that the Subject violated Chapter 491, Florida Statutes.

It is therefore, ORDERED that the complaint be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
