CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complaint alleges that the Subject violated Section 491.009(2)(k), Florida Statutes, by engaging in sexual misconduct in the practice of a profession; also, a violation of Section 491.009(2)(s), Florida Statutes, by practicing below the minimum standards of a profession.


THE FACTS: The Complainant went to the Subject for counseling services. These services were allegedly inadequate, according to the Complainant, because the Subject made sexual advances toward her during her sessions. The Subject was contacted and denied the allegation.

Investigation revealed no sexual misconduct by the Subject. However, a departmental consultant recommends that the Subject should thoroughly review the therapeutic history of patients he inherits as it would assist him in dealing with his patients more appropriately.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, probable cause does exist to believe that the Subject violated Chapter 491, Florida Statutes. However, this case will be closed with a Letter of Guidance issued to the Subject.

It is therefore, ORDERED that the complaint be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
