CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complaint alleges that the Subject violated Section 490.012, Florida Statutes, by holding himself out as a psychologist without proper licensure.

THE FACTS: The Subject has had three (3) prior complaints. Case numbers 90-14778, 90-2292 and 102241 were closed with the issuance of a Notice to Cease and Desist.

Investigation has failed to disclose any unlicensed activity since issuance of the last Notice to Cease and Desist in February, 1991. This case, along with all of the Subject's prior cases, have been referred for criminal prosecution.

In addition, a complaint has been initiated against the Subject's mental health counseling license.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, probable cause does exist to believe that the Subject violated Chapter 490, Florida Statutes.

It is therefore, ORDERED that the complaint be and the same is hereby CLOSED.
