Teen Screen is a tool, not a psychological evaluation

Penn – Pilot 2003-2004
Sent consent forms home – little return

Fall 2004

Passive Consent – letter sent home to families attached to the Newsletter stating to call if they don't want their child doing this screening. **Deadline will be October 28.**

Homerooms will be scheduled – 10th grade only
Kids will be assigned a #; name will only be on 1 page

10-15 minutes – screening done on a flat screen computer (approximately 10 kids at a time) to show significance in the following areas: anxiety, phobia, panic attacks, suicidal ideation, adjustment issues, etc.

****Low level of significance** – debriefing & back to class

****if the screen shows a student to be at risk – talk to Ed** (Masters level therapist) 30-45 minutes.

****call home – level of high risk** for suicide or major concern. Letter will go home with names of therapists for recommendations (not necessarily from Madison Center)

****follow up in a few weeks with the parents.**

****If a student needs to be hospitalized and is, Madison Center will pay for the stay for stability.**

Need 14 scheduled dates for homerooms to attend. Begin November on Gold days T, Th, & F only

Therapists will need a class list (mark off the students who will not participate)

*All kids will be debriefed after screening

October 11 – Steve Bright will come to the counselor's meeting to explain the program to the guidance dept.

Rooms to use – guidance conference room / debriefing in room next to Rhonda's
Another conference room / debriefing in ?

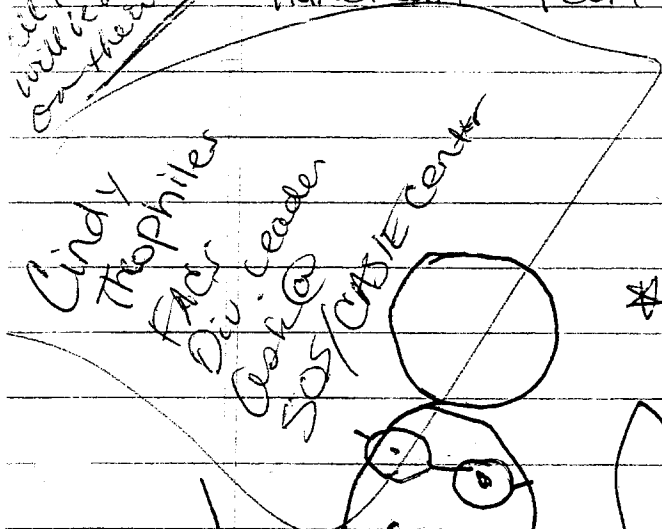

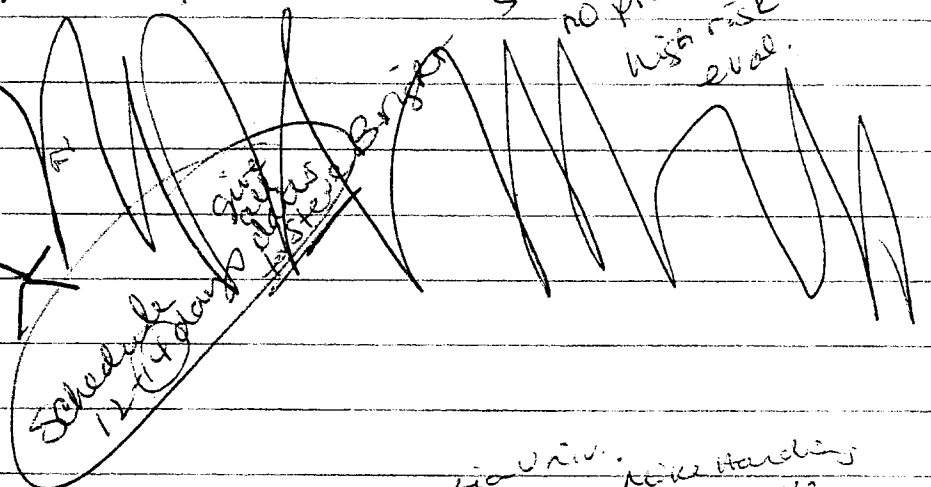
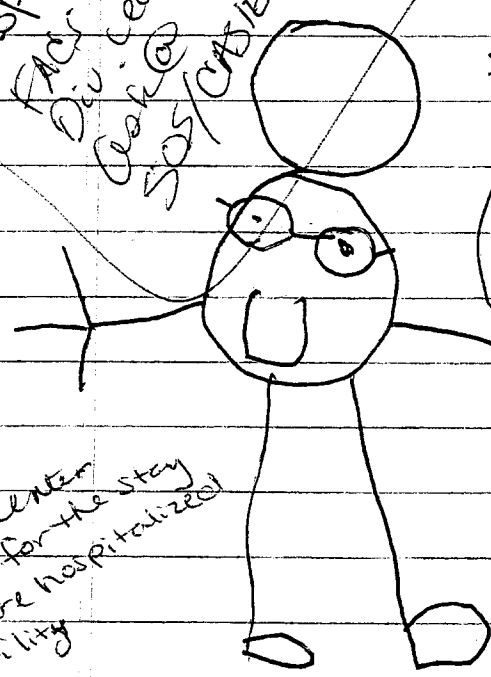
