**AGREEMENT FOR

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**TO ALL PARTIES:**

**IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED** by and between the parties to the above-entitled proceedings, that the following matters are true:

1. Complainant, Linda K. Whitney, is the Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs ("Board").
2. David L. Hoban, M.D., ("Respondent") has carefully read and fully understands the effect of this Agreement.
3. Respondent understands that by signing this Agreement he is enabling the Medical Board of California to issue this order accepting the surrender of license without further process. Respondent understands and agrees that Board staff and counsel for complainant may communicate directly with the Board regarding this Agreement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. The Board will not be disqualified from further action in this matter by virtue of its consideration of this Agreement.

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1           4.       Respondent acknowledges there is current disciplinary action against his license, that  
2 on July 20, 2010, an Accusation was filed against him and on September 30, 2011, a Decision was  
3 rendered wherein his license was revoked, with the revocation stayed, 5 years probation, various  
4 terms and conditions.


5                   a)       The current disciplinary action provides in pertinent part, "Following the  
6 effective date of this decision, if respondent ceases practicing due to retirement, health reasons, or is  
7 otherwise unable to satisfy the terms and conditions of probation, respondent may request the  
8 voluntary surrender of respondent's license." (Case No. 03-2010-204516)

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10           5.       Upon acceptance of the Agreement by the Board, Respondent understands  
11 he will no longer be permitted to practice as a physician and surgeon in California, and also agrees to  
12 surrender his wallet certificate, wall license and D.E.A. Certificate(s).

13           6.       Respondent hereby represents that he does not intend to seek re-licensure or  
14 reinstatement as a physician and surgeon. Respondent fully understands and agrees, however, that if  
15 Respondent ever files an application for re-licensure or reinstatement in the State of California, the  
16 Board shall treat it as a Petition for Reinstatement of a revoked license in effect at the time the  
17 Petition is filed. In addition, any Medical Board Investigation Report(s), including all referenced  
18 documents and other exhibits, upon which the Board is predicated, and any such Investigation  
19 Report(s), attachments, and other exhibits, that may be generated subsequent to the filing of this  
20 Agreement for Surrender of License, shall be admissible as direct evidence, and any time-based  
21 defenses, such as laches or any applicable statute of limitations, shall be waived when the Board  
22 determines whether to grant or deny the Petition.  
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
ACCEPTANCE


