

Public Letter of Reprimand

An investigation by the Medical Board of California revealed that you were negligent in the care and treatment provided to two patients, by failing to maintain adequate medical records on both patient's, using an antipsychotic agent on one patient, not FDA approved for adjunctive treatment for depression and starting the other patient on medication that could worsen and lead to dangerous consequences.

These actions are in violation of California B&P Code sections 2234(c) – repeated negligent acts and 2266 – failure to maintain adequate and accurate medical records.

Pursuant to the authority of the California Business and Professions Code section 2233, you are hereby issued this Public Letter of Reprimand by the Medical Board of California.
