CEASE PRACTICE ORDER


In the Medical Board of California (Board) Case No. 800-2014-007056, the Board issued a Decision adopting a Stipulated Settlement, which became effective November 21, 2018. In the Board's Order, Physician's and Surgeon's License No. C 27700, issued to Ronald H. Onkin, M.D., was placed on probation.

Probationary Condition No. 4 – Monitoring-Practice, requires Respondent to submit to the Board or its designee for prior approval as a practice monitor, the name and qualifications of one or more licensed physicians and surgeons whose licenses are valid and in good standing and who are preferably American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS) certified within 30 days.

If Respondent fails to obtain approval of a monitor within 60 calendar days of the effective date of this Decision, Respondent shall receive a notification from the Board or its designee to cease the practice of medicine within three (3) calendar days after being so notified. Respondent shall cease the practice of medicine until a monitor is approved to provide monitoring responsibility.

The Respondent has failed to obey Probationary Condition No. 4 as ordered in the above Decision, by failing to obtain an approved practice monitor or a replacement monitor within 60 days. Accordingly, Respondent, Ronald H. Onkin, M.D., is prohibited from engaging in the practice of medicine. The Respondent shall not resume the practice of medicine until a monitor is approved by the Board to provide monitoring responsibility.
