CEASE PRACTICE ORDER

In the Medical Board of California (Board) Case No. 800-2016-028304, the Board issued a Decision After Non-Adoption, which became effective January 18, 2019. In the Board's Order, Physician's and Surgeon's License No. G 56228, issued to Margaret Melinda Sprague, M.D., was revoked, with the order stayed, and Respondent placed on probation for five years with terms and conditions.

Probationary Condition No. 5 Biological Fluid Testing; Probationary Condition No. 8 Violation of Probation for Substance Abusing Licensees; Probationary Condition No. 10 Alcohol – Abstain from Use.

The Respondent has failed to obey Probationary Condition No. 10 as ordered in the above Decision, by testing positive for the metabolites of alcohol on July 7, 2021. Accordingly, Respondent, Margaret Melinda Sprague, M.D., is prohibited from engaging in the practice of medicine. The Respondent shall not resume the practice of medicine until she undergoes a clinical diagnostic evaluation and has 30 days of negative biological fluid testing.
