INTERIM SUSPENSION ORDER

(Govt. Code, § 11529)

Administrative Law Judge Karen Reichmann, Office of Administrative Hearings,
State of California, heard this matter on May 5, 2021, by videoconference.

Deputy Attorney General Thomas Ostly represented petitioner William Prasifka, Executive Director of the Medical Board of California, Department of Consumer Affairs.

Attorney Robert Hodges represented respondent Xiaoling Zhu, M.D., who was present.

1. The petition and supporting documents, respondent's declaration and supporting documents, and the arguments made at hearing have been considered. Good cause having been established, the petition is granted. Physician's and Surgeon's Certificate No. A 98460, issued to respondent Xiaoling Zhu, M.D., is suspended. Respondent Xiaoling Zhu, M.D., is immediately restrained and prohibited from:

(a) practicing or attempting to practice as a physician and surgeon in California;

(b) prescribing, dispensing, furnishing, administering, or otherwise distributing any controlled substance or dangerous drug; and

(c) possessing or holding physician's and surgeon's wall and/or wallet certificates, any and all controlled substance or dangerous drug prescription forms, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) Drug Order Forms, and any and all DEA permits, which documents shall be surrendered by respondent to the Medical Board of California, or its designated representative, for safekeeping, upon demand, pending the final decision in the accusation to be filed in this matter.

2. This order shall remain in effect until a final decision and order has been issued by the Medical Board. If an accusation is not filed and served on respondent within 30 days, the order shall be dissolved.
