
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED

This Order shall take effect upon being filed with the Clerk of the Department of Health.



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**AMENDED MOTION TO VACATE FINAL ORDER AND  
REINSTATE RESPONDENT'S MEDICAL LICENSE**

COMES NOW Petitioner, Department of Health ("Department"), by and through undersigned counsel, and moves the Board of Medicine for the entry of an order vacating and setting aside its Final Order of April 23, 2009 and to reinstate Respondent's medical license. As grounds therefore, Petitioner would show:

1. The entry of the Final Order filed April 23, 2009, resulted from the failure of Respondent, Lawrence Kamhi, M.D., to respond to the Administrative Complaint which alleged Respondent's practitioner profile incorrectly indicated he was board certified by the American Board of Anesthesiology. A copy of the Administrative Complaint and

Final Order are attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit 1".

2. Subsequent to Respondent's presentation to the Board of Medicine on April 9, 2010, Petitioner reviewed the entire record in consideration of this matter. This review reflects that Respondent notified the Department by facsimile prior to being licensed that he was in error by claiming board certification on his initial application. However, his practitioner profile information, which was based on his original application, was not corrected by the Department prior to licensure. The Department made an error in publishing Dr. Kamhi's practitioner profile with incorrect information after Dr. Kamhi had notified the Department with the correct information. Although Respondent was asked to review his practitioner profile prior to publication to ensure it was correct, he failed to do so. Nonetheless, the Department was also in error by publishing incorrect information which Respondent had previously corrected. A copy of the documents received from Respondent to timely correct his application for licensure are attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit 2".

3. As Respondent's application for licensure was received on March 24, 2004, the correction of the information to "board eligible" as opposed to "board certified" was timely and there is no need for the underlying disciplinary action set forth in the Administrative Complaint. The timeline presented by Petitioner is attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Exhibit 3".


4. It is the duty of the attorney for Petitioner, in the interest of justice, to ensure that the relevant facts regarding the Department's role in this error on Dr. Kamhi's practitioner profile be clearly presented and considered by the Board of Medicine.

5. The Board of Medicine has the inherent or implied authority to rehear or reopen a case to reconsider the action taken therein, where the proceeding is in essence a judicial proceeding. See *Smull v. Town of Jupiter*, 854 So.2d 780, 782 (Fla. 4th DCA 2003).

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board of Medicine enter an order vacating the Final Order filed in Case No. 2008-13925 and enter a Final Order reinstating Respondent's medical license.



FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the BOARD OF MEDICINE (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, on, 2009, in , Florida, for consideration of the Administrative Complaint (attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the above-styled cause pursuant to Respondent's Election of Rights. Respondent was served with the Administrative Complaint by personal service. Because Respondent failed to submit an Election of Rights or otherwise dispute the facts or respond in any other way, Respondent waived the right to a hearing pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. At the hearing, Petitioner was represented by Shirley Bates, Assistant General Counsel. Respondent was not present and was not represented by counsel. The facts are not in dispute.

Upon consideration, it is ORDERED:

1. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the findings of fact by the Board.

2. The conclusions of law alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the conclusions of law by the Board.

3. The violations set forth warrant disciplinary action by the Board.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000.00 to the Board within 30 days from the date this Final Order is filed.

2. Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of Florida is hereby SUSPENDED until such time as he personally appears before the Board. The Board retains jurisdiction in this matter to impose additional terms or conditions of probation at the time of reinstatement of licensure.

RULING ON MOTION TO ASSESS COSTS

The Board reviewed the Petitioner's Motion to Assess Costs and imposes the costs associated with this case in the amount of \$877.13. Said costs are to be paid within 30 days from the date this Final Order is filed.



**ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT**

COMES NOW, Petitioner, Department of Health, by and through its undersigned counsel, and files this Administrative Complaint before the Board of Medicine against Respondent, Lawrence Mitchell Kamhi, M.D., and in support thereof alleges:

1. Petitioner is the state department charged with regulating the practice of medicine pursuant to Section 20.43, Florida Statutes; Chapter 456, Florida Statutes; and Chapter 458, Florida Statutes.
2. At all times material to this Complaint, Respondent was a licensed physician within the State of Florida, having been issued license number ME 93142.
3. Respondent's address of record is 180 Montague Street, Suite 29-E, Brooklyn, New York 11201.

4. At all times material to this complaint, Respondent claimed to be board certified by the American Board of Anesthesiology on his Florida Department of Health practitioner's profile.

5. At all times material to this complaint, Respondent was not board certified by the American Board of Anesthesiology.

### COUNT ONE

6. Petitioner realleges and incorporates paragraphs one (1) through five (5) as if fully set forth herein.

7. Section 458.331(1)(II), Florida Statutes (2007), provides that holding oneself out as a board-certified specialist, if not qualified under Section 458.3312 Florida Statutes (2007), constitutes grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.

8. Respondent holds himself out as board certified in anesthesiology when he is not.

9. Based on the foregoing, Respondent has violated Section 458.331(1)(II), Florida Statutes (2007), by claiming to be certified by the American Board of Anesthesiology on his Florida Department of Health practitioner's profile.

## COUNT TWO

10. Petitioner realleges and incorporates paragraphs one (1) through five (5) as if fully set forth herein.

11. Section 458.331(1)(nn), Florida Statutes (2007), violating any provision of Chapter 458 or Chapter 456, or any rules adopted pursuant thereto constitutes grounds for disciplinary action by the Board.

12. Respondent held himself out as board certified in anesthesiology contrary to the provisions of Section 458.3312 Florida Statutes (2007).


13. Based on the foregoing, Respondent has violated Section 458.331(1)(nn), Florida Statutes (2007), by violating Section 458.331(1)(II) Florida Statutes (2007), by holding himself out as being a board-certified specialist when he is not in violation of Section 458.3312 Florida Statutes (2007).

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board of Medicine enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties: permanent revocation or suspension of Respondent's license, restriction of practice, imposition of an administrative fine, issuance of a reprimand, placement of the Respondent on probation, corrective action, refund of

fees billed or collected, remedial education and/or any other relief that the Board deems appropriate.

**MOTION TO ASSESS COSTS**  
**IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 456.072(4)**

COMES NOW the Department of Health, by and through undersigned counsel, and moves the Board of Medicine for the entry of a Final Order assessing costs against the Respondent for the investigation and prosecution of this case in accordance with Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes (2003). As grounds therefore, the Petitioner states the following:

1. At its next regularly scheduled meeting, the Board of Medicine will take up for consideration the above-styled disciplinary action and will enter a Final Order therein.
2. Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes (2003),<sup>1</sup> states as follows:

In addition to any other discipline imposed through final order, or citation, entered on or after July 1, 2001, pursuant to this section or discipline imposed through final order, or citation, entered on or after July 1, 2001, for a violation of any practice act, the board, or the department when there is not board, shall assess costs related to the investigation and prosecution of the case. Such costs related to the investigation and prosecution include, but are not limited to, salaries and benefits of personnel, costs related to the time spent by the attorney and other personnel working on the case, and any other expenses incurred by the department for the case. The board, or the department when there is no board, shall determine the amount of costs to be assessed after its consideration of an affidavit of itemized costs and any written objections thereto. . . . (emphasis added)

3. The investigation and prosecution of this case has resulted in costs in the total amount of \$877.13, based on the following itemized statement of costs:

- a. Total costs for Complaints \$147.73
- b. Total costs for Investigations \$104.65
- c. Total costs for Legal \$624.75
- d. Total costs for expenses \$0

Therefore, the Petitioner seeks an assessment of costs against the Respondent in the amount of \$877.13, as evidenced in the attached affidavit. (Exhibit A).

4. Should the Respondent file written objections to the assessment of costs, within ten (10) days of the date of this motion,


specifying the grounds for the objections and the specific elements of the costs to which the objections are made, the Petitioner requests that the Board determine the amount of costs to be assessed based upon its consideration of the affidavit attached as Exhibit A and any timely-filed written objections.



**BEFORE ME**, the undersigned authority, personally appeared **JAMES R. COOKSEY**, who was sworn and states as follows:

- 1) My name is James R. Cooksey.
- 2) I am over the age of 18, competent to testify, and make this affidavit upon my own personal knowledge and after review of the records at the Florida Department of Health (DOH).
- 3) I am an Operations Management Consultant for the Consumer Services Unit for DOH. The Consumer Services Unit is where all complaints against Florida health care licensees (e.g., medical doctors, dentists, nurses, respiratory therapists) are officially filed. I have been in my current job position for more than one year. My business address is 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Bin C-75, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3275.
- 4) As an Operations Management Consultant, my job duties include reviewing data in the Time Tracking System and verifying that the amounts correspond. The Time Tracking System is a computer program which records and tracks DOH's costs regarding the investigation and prosecution of cases against Florida health care licensees.
- 5) As of today, DOH's total costs for investigating and prosecuting DOH case number 2008-13925 (Department of Health v. Lawrence Kamhi, M.D.) are eight hundred seventy-seven dollars and thirteen cents (**\$877.13**).
- 6) The costs for DOH case number 2008-13925 (Department of Health v. Lawrence Kamhi, M.D.) are summarized in Exhibit 1 (Cost Summary Report), which is attached to this document.
- 7) The itemized costs and expenses for DOH case number 2008-13925 (Department of Health v. Lawrence Kamhi, M.D.) are detailed in Exhibit 2 (Itemized Cost Report and Itemized Expense Report and receipts), which is attached to this document.
- 8) The itemized costs as reflected in Exhibit 2 are determined by the following method: DOH employees who work on cases daily are to keep track of their time in six-minute increments (e.g., investigators

and lawyers). A designated DOH employee in the Consumer Services Unit, Legal Department, and in each area office, inputs the time worked and expenses spent into the Time Tracking System. Time and expenses are charged against a state health care Board (e.g., Florida Board of Medicine, Florida Board of Dentistry, Florida Board of Osteopathic Medicine), and/or a case. If no Board or case can be charged, then the time and expenses are charged as administrative time. The hourly rate of each employee is calculated by formulas established by the Department. (See the Itemized Cost Report)

9) James R. Cooksey, first being duly sworn, states that he has read the foregoing Affidavit and its attachments and the statements contained therein are true and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief.

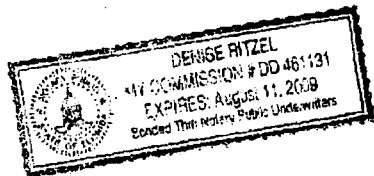
