### FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the BOARD OF MEDICINE (Board)

pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes, on

April 6, 2018, in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the

Administrative Complaint (attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the

above-styled cause pursuant to Respondent's Election of Rights.

At the hearing, Petitioner was represented by Jasmine Green,

Assistant General Counsel. Respondent was not present and was

not represented by counsel. The facts are not in dispute.

Upon consideration, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the findings of fact by the Board.
- 2. The conclusions of law alleged and set forth in the Administrative Complaint are approved and adopted and

incorporated herein by reference as the conclusions of law by the Board.

3. The violations set forth warrant disciplinary action by the Board.

### THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00 to the Board within 30 days from the date the Final Order is filed. Said fine shall be paid by money order or cashier's check.
- 2. Respondent's license to practice medicine in the State of Florida is hereby SUSPENDED until such time as she demonstrates that her license to practice medicine in all jurisdictions is unencumbered and she demonstrates the ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety. Such demonstration of skill and safety shall include an evaluation by the Professionals Resource Network (PRN). The Respondent shall appear before the Board with said PRN evaluation and the Board shall make the determination of whether Respondent is safe to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety. The Board retains jurisdiction in this matter to impose terms and conditions upon reinstatement of Respondent's license, including, but not limited to, a period of probation with said terms and conditions to be set at the time of reinstatement.

3. Respondent shall be and is hereby issued a letter of concern by the Board.

### RULING ON MOTION TO ASSESS COSTS

The Board reviewed the Petitioner's Motion to Assess Costs and voted to waive the costs associated with this case.

### MOTION TO ASSESS COSTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 456.072(4)

The Department of Health, by and through counsel, moves the Board of Medicine for entry of a Final Order assessing costs against Respondent for the investigation and prosecution of this case in accordance with Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes (2016). As grounds therefore, the Petitioner states the following:

- At its next regularly scheduled meeting, the Board of Medicine will take up for consideration the above-styled disciplinary action and will enter a Final Order.
- 2. Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes (2016), states, in pertinent part, as follows:

In addition to any other discipline imposed through final order, or citation, entered on or after July 1, 2001, under this section or discipline imposed through final order, or citation, entered on or after July 1, 2001, for a violation of any practice act, the board, or the department when there is no board, shall assess costs related to the investigation and prosecution of the case. The costs related to the investigation and prosecution include, but are not limited to, salaries and benefits of personnel, costs related to the time spent by the attorney and other personnel working on the case, and any other expenses incurred by the department for the case. The board, or the department when there is no board, shall determine the amount of costs to be assessed after its consideration of an affidavit of itemized costs and any written objections thereto. ...

- 3. As evidenced in the attached affidavit (Exhibit A), the investigation and prosecution of this case has resulted in costs in the total amount of \$1,856.81, based on the following itemized statement of costs:
  - a. Total costs for Complaint \$85.45
  - b. Total costs for Investigation \$48.82
  - c. Total costs for Legal \$1,722.54
  - d. Total costs for Expenses \$0
- 4. The attached affidavit reflects the Department's costs for attorney time in this case as \$ 1,722.54 (Exhibit A). The cost of obtaining an affidavit from an outside attorney will exceed this amount. Therefore, the Department is not seeking costs for attorney time in this case.

- 5. Should Respondent file written objections to the assessment of costs, within ten (10) days of the date of this motion, specifying the grounds for the objections and the specific elements of the costs to which objections are made, Petitioner requests that the Board determine the amount of costs to be assessed based upon its consideration of the affidavits attached as Exhibit A and any timely-filed written objections.
- 6. Petitioner requests that the Board grant this motion and assess costs in the amount of \$134.27 as supported by competent, substantial evidence. This assessment of costs is in addition to any other discipline imposed by the Board and is in accordance with Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes (2016).

WHEREFORE, the Department of Health requests that the Board of Medicine enter a Final Order assessing costs against Respondent in the amount of \$134.27.

- 1) My name is Shane Walters.
- 2) I am over the age of 18, competent to testify, and make this affidavit upon my own personal knowledge and after review of the records at the Florida Department of Health (DOH).
- 3) I am the Senior Management Analyst II (SMAII) for the Consumer Services and Compliance Management Unit for DOH. The Consumer Services Unit is where all complaints against Florida health care licensees (e.g., medical doctors, dentists, nurses, respiratory therapists) are officially filed. I have been in my current job position for more than one year. My business address is 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Bin C-75 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3275.
- 4) As SMAII of the Consumer Services and Compliance Management Unit, my job duties include reviewing data in the Time Tracking System and verifying that the amounts correspond. The Time Tracking System is a computer program which records and tracks DOH's costs regarding the investigation and prosecution of cases against Florida health care licensees.
- 5) As of today, DOH's total costs for investigating and prosecuting DOH case number(s) 2017-05001 (Department of Health v Laura Jean Seed, M.D.) are ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-ONE CENTS (\$1,856.81).
- 6) The costs for DOH case numbers **2017-05001** (Department of Health v. Laura Jean Seed, M.D.) are summarized in Exhibit 1 (Cost Summary Report), which is attached to this document.
- 7) The itemized costs and expenses for DOH case numbers 2017-05001 (Department of Health v. Laura Jean Seed, M.D.) are detailed in Exhibit 2 (Itemized Cost Report and Itemized Expense Report and receipts), which is attached to this document.
- 8) The itemized costs as reflected in Exhibit 2 are determined by the following method: DOH employees who work on cases daily are to keep track of their time in six-minute increments (e.g., investigators

and lawyers). A designated DOH employee in the Consumer Services Unit, Legal Department, and in each area office, inputs the time worked and expenses spent into the Time Tracking System. Time and expenses are charged against a state health care Board (e.g., Florida Board of Medicine, Florida Board of Dentistry, Florida Board of Osteopathic Medicine), and/or a case. If no Board or case can be charged, then the time and expenses are charged as administrative time. The hourly rate of each employee is calculated by formulas established by the Department. (See the Itemized Cost Report)

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### ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

Petitioner Department of Health files this Administrative Complaint before the Board of Medicine against Respondent Laura Jean Seed, M.D., and in support thereof alleges:

- 1. Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of Medicine pursuant to Section 20.43, Florida Statutes; Chapter 456, Florida Statutes; and Chapter 458, Florida Statutes.
- 2. At all times material to this Complaint, Respondent was a licensed medical doctor within the state of Florida, having been issued license number ME 129935.
- 3. Respondent's address of record is 4440 Caminito Cuarzo, San Diego, California 92117.

- 4. Respondent is also licensed to practice medicine in the state of California by the Medical Board of California (California Board), the licensing authority regulating the practice of medicine in California.
- 5. On or about March 29, 2017, the California Board took action against Respondent's license in case number 8002015017881 via a Stipulation of the Parties Re: Interim Suspension Order and Order for the following reasons:
  - a. Respondent engaged in acts that violate the Medical Practice
     Act;
  - b. Respondent is unable to practice safely due to a mental condition;
  - c. Permitting respondent to continue practicing medicine will endanger the public health, safety and welfare; and,
  - d. Respondent's actions constituted potential serious injury to the public.
- 6. The Stipulation suspended Respondent's license to practice medicine in the state of California indefinitely until the issuance of a final Decision and Order by the California Board on an accusation filed against her.

- 7. The March 29, 2017 Stipulation of the California Board constitutes action against Respondent's medical license.
- 8. Section 458.331(1)(b), Florida Statutes (2016), provides that having a license or the authority to practice medicine revoked, suspended, or otherwise acted against, including the denial of licensure, by the licensing authority of any jurisdiction constitutes grounds for disciplinary action by the Board of Medicine. The licensing authority's acceptance of a physician's relinquishment of a license, stipulation, consent order, or other settlement, offered in response to or in anticipation of the filing of administrative charges against the physician's license, shall be construed as action against the physician's license.
- 9. The California Board acted against Respondent's California medical license by entering the above referenced Stipulation on or about March 29, 2017.
- 10. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 458.331(1)(b), Florida Statutes (2016), by having her medical license acted against by the medical licensing authority of another jurisdiction.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner respectfully requests that the Board of Medicine enter an order imposing one or more of the following penalties:

permanent revocation or suspension of Respondent's license, restriction of practice, imposition of an administrative fine, issuance of a reprimand, placement of the Respondent on probation, corrective action, refund of fees billed or collected, remedial education and/or any other relief that the Board deems appropriate.

Respondent has the right to request a hearing to be conducted in accordance with Section 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes, to be represented by counsel or other qualified representative, to present evidence and argument, to call and cross-examine witnesses and to have subpoena and subpoena duces tecum issued on his or her behalf if a hearing is requested.

A request or petition for an administrative hearing must be in writing and must be received by the Department within 21 days from the day Respondent received the Administrative Complaint, pursuant to Rule 28-106.111(2), Florida Administrative Code. If Respondent fails to request a hearing within 21 days of receipt of this Administrative Complaint, Respondent waives the right to request a hearing on the facts alleged in this Administrative Complaint pursuant to Rule 28-106.111(4), Florida Administrative Code. Any request for an administrative proceeding to challenge or contest the material facts or charges contained in the Administrative Complaint must conform to Rule 28-106.2015(5), Florida Administrative Code.

Mediation under Section 120.573, Florida Statutes, is not available to resolve this Administrative Complaint.

### **NOTICE REGARDING ASSESSMENT OF COSTS**

Respondent is placed on notice that Petitioner has incurred costs related to the Investigation and prosecution of this matter. Pursuant to Section 456.072(4), Florida Statutes, the Board shall assess costs related to the investigation and prosecution of a disciplinary matter, which may include attorney hours and costs, on the Respondent in addition to any other discipline imposed.
