CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleges that Subject failed to keep written medical records in violation of Section 458.331 (1)(n), Florida Statutes.

THE FACTS: According to Complainant, Subject's medical privileges were suspended from Daytona Community Hospital following an action taken by the State Board of Medical Examiners on June 15, 1983.


The facts and circumstances surrounding the suspension were considered by the Probable Cause Panel in case number 0025337.

There being no additional charges brought against Subject, the matter does not warrant further investigation or prosecution.

THE LAW: Probable cause does exist to believe that Subject violated Section 458.331(1)(n), Florida Statutes. However, the Board has previously taken disciplinary action on the violation set forth in the investigative report and further disciplinary proceedings are not warranted.

Therefore, this complaint should be and the same is hereby dismissed.
