CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: The Department of Professional Regulation alleged that the Subject of this investigation exercised influence in the physician/patient relationship for the purposes of engaging the patient in sexual activity; practiced medicine below acceptable levels of care, skill and treatment; prescribed a controlled substance, cannabis, to a patient outside the course of the physician/patient relationship; failed to maintain adequate records to justify his treatment of the patient; and performed professional services not authorized by the patient or client.

THE FACTS: The initial investigation substantiated the allegations. Therefore, a finding of probable cause was properly made and the Department was directed to file an Administrative Complaint. However, the only witness to the Subject's actions has since died. Therefore, the Department can no longer prove its case by clear and convincing evidence.

THE LAW: Probable cause was previously properly found. However, in view of the foregoing, this case should be closed without further action.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be and
the same is hereby CLOSED.
