CLOSING ORDER


THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleged Subject was guilty of malpractice.

THE FACTS: Investigation substantiated the allegations. Subject is now the Subject of other administrative proceedings which will lead to the revocation of his license. He is presently not locatable. Cause for further formal prosecution is not present. These cases will be pursued should the license regain/retain licensure.

THE LAW: Based upon the foregoing, there is sufficient probable cause to believe that an actionable violation of Chapter 458, Florida Statutes or the rules promulgated thereunder has occurred. No action needs to be further taken in this matter.

It is, therefore, ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the foregoing matter be, and the same is hereby, DISMISSED.
