- Petitioner is the state agency charged with regulating the practice of medicine pursuant to Section 20.30, Florida Statutes; Chapter 455, Florida Statutes; and Chapter 458, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Respondent is and has been at all times material tereto a linensed physician in the State of Florida, having been issued linense number ME 0026353. Respondent's last known address is 11880 S.W. 40th Street, Suite 207, Miami, Florida 31175.
- 3. From on or about December 6, 1984 to December 1985, Bespondent rendered medical care to patient Journal Communications.
- 4. In or about December 1985, Respondent released patient medical records despite specific instructions by her mot release them.
- Respondent released patient records without written authorization by the patient as described by Section 455.241(2), Florida Statutes.
- 6. Based on the foregoing, Respondent violated Section 458.33%(1)(g), Florida Statutes, by failing to perform any statutory or legal obligation placed upon a licensed physician.
