CLOSING ORDER

THE COMPLAINT: Complainant alleges that the Subject of the investigation failed to keep written medical records justifying the course of treatment of the patient, in that his staff privileges at the Bayonet Point/Hudson Regional Medical Center were suspended because he had not completed delinquent medical charts.

THE FACTS: Investigation substantiated the allegations. Subject has subsequently taken corrective action and has reapplied for staff privileges.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, there is sufficient probable cause to believe that a violation of Chapter 458, Florida Statutes, has occurred. However, as corrective action has been taken, the Subject is being issued a Letter of Guidance.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be, and the same is hereby dismissed.
