Patient came in 4-77 with tatoo on her upper right thigh, Butterfly with Jack & Mac Patient was pregnant at time and it was decided to wait until baby was born to remove tatoo. Ins'd advised the procedure be done by excising in several sections over a period of time. Patient refused and insured used light demabrasion and mild salibrasion. The patient was in for a total of 44 visits and 12 skin grafts because she had infections which were treated with antibiotics. She had problems with the grafts because she said baby kicked her.
