CLOSING ORDER


THE COMPLAINT: Complaint alleges that the Subject of the investigation failed to perform a statutory or legal obligation placed upon a physician by failing to furnish the patient with a copy of the results of a Post-Traumatic Stress Examination upon patient's request.

THE FACTS: Investigation revealed that Complaint was referred to Subject by the Veteran's Administration for a Post-Traumatic Stress Examination. Subject provided the V.A. with the results, however, he did not furnish a copy of the report to the Complainant upon request. The Subject has subsequently provided the patient with a copy of the report after being contacted by the Department.

THE LAW: Based on the foregoing, there is insufficient evidence to support a finding of probable cause of violation of Section 455.241(1), Florida Statutes has occurred. However, under the circumstances, a Letter of Guidance will be issued.

It is, therefore, ORDERED that this matter should be and the same is hereby CLOSED with a Letter of Guidance.
