CONSENT ORDER

The Department of Professional Regulation by David K. Iwasaki, one of its attorneys, and Evert M. Vander Stoep, Respondent, hereby agree to the following:

STIPULATIONS

Evert M. Vander Stoep is licensed as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois, holding license No. 036-038186. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Department of Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

Information has come to the attention of the Department that Respondent was late in renewing his medical license and practiced without a license from August 1, 1993 to February 22, 1994.

The allegation(s) as set forth herein, if proven to be true would constitute grounds for suspending or revoking Respondent's license as a Physician, on the authority of Illinois Compiled Statutes (1992), Chapter 225, paragraph(s) 60/3, 60/21(A), and 60/22 A(13).

As a result of the foregoing allegation(s), the Department held an Informal Conference at the offices of the Department,

100 West Randolph Street, Suite 9-300, Chicago, Illinois 60601 on March 1, 1995. Respondent appeared in person on that date, represented by Richard Kleinman. Eloy Moscoso appeared as a member of the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Illinois and David K. Igasaki appeared as an attorney for the Department.

Respondent admits the allegations stated in this Order.

Respondent has been advised of the right to have the pending allegation(s) reduced to written charges, the right to a hearing, the right to contest any charges brought, and the right to administrative review of any Order resulting from a hearing. Respondent knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as any right to administrative review of this Consent Order.

Respondent and the Department have agreed, in order to resolve this matter, that Evert M. Vander Stoep be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures which are fair and equitable in the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interests of the people of the State of Illinois.

CONDITIONS

WHEREFORE, the Department, through David K. Igasaki, its attorney, and Evert M. Vander Stoep, agree:

- A. Respondent's license No. 036-038186 is Reprimanded by this Consent Order.
- B. Respondent shall pay a Two Thousand and Three Hundred (\$2,300.00) Dollar fine to the Illinois Department of Professional Regulation within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this Order, Respondent's financial circumstances requiring this time to pay.

- C. Any violation by Respondent of the terms and conditions of this Consent Order shall be grounds for the Department to immediately file a Complaint to revoke the Respondent's license to practice as a Physician in the State of Illinois.
- D. This Consent Order shall become effective immediately after it is approved by the Director of the Department.
