**CONSENT ORDER**

The Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, by Jaroslaw Kosacz, one of its attorneys, and Terence C. Casey, Respondent, hereby agree to the following:

**STIPULATIONS**

Terence C. Casey, ("Respondent") is licensed as a Physician and Surgeon in the State of Illinois, holding license No. 036-123064, issued by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois. Said license is presently in ACTIVE status. At all times material to the matter set forth in this Consent Order, the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois, Division of Professional Regulation ("the Department") has had jurisdiction over the subject matter and parties herein.

Information has recently come to the attention of the Department that Respondent's Tennessee physician and surgeon license was disciplined for unprofessional conduct.

The allegations if proven to be true, would constitute grounds for the Department to revoke, suspend, or otherwise discipline Respondent's license as a Physician and Surgeon on the authority of 225 ILCS 60/22 (A)(12).

Respondent has been advised of the right to counsel, the right to have the pending allegations reduced to written charges, the right to a hearing, the right to contest any charges brought, and the right to administrative review of any Order resulting from a hearing. Respondent knowingly waives each of these rights, as well as any right to administrative review of this Consent Order.

Respondent and the Department have agreed, in order to resolve this matter, that Respondent be permitted to enter into a Consent Order with the Department, providing for the imposition of disciplinary measures which are fair and equitable in the circumstances and which are consistent with the best interests of the people of the State of Illinois. Respondent has freely and willfully entered into this Consent Order without any threat or coercion by any person. Respondent has not relied on any statements or promises made by or on behalf of the Department other than those specifically set forth in writing herein.

### **CONDITIONS**

WHEREFORE, the Department, through Jaroslaw Kosacz, its attorney, and Terence C. Casey, agree:

- A. That Respondent's Illinois Physician and Surgeon license shall be publicly reprimanded.
- B. This Consent Order shall become effective immediately upon signing and approval by the Director of the Division.

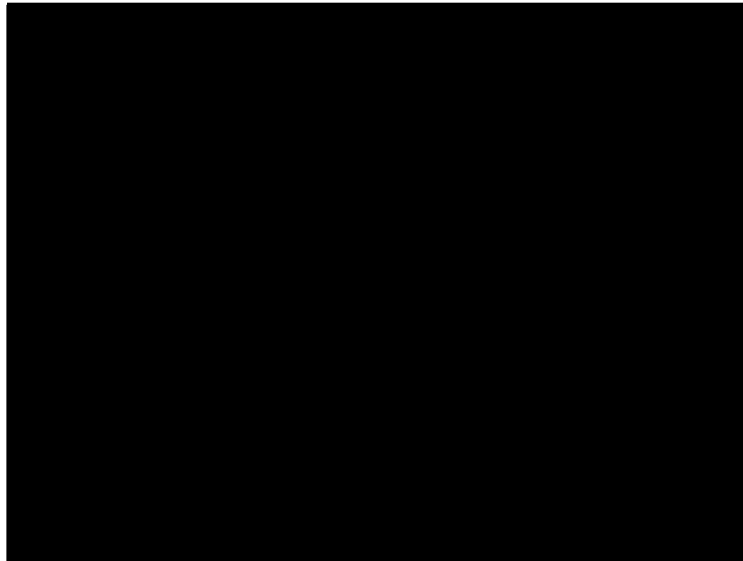


