**ORDER**

This matter having come before the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, for the automatic, indefinite and immediate Suspension of the Illinois Physician and Surgeon License of Emily M. Hoag, M.D., for a minimum period of twelve (12) months.

Now therefore I, Cecilia Abundis, Director of the Division of Professional Regulation of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, after reviewing this matter and the exhibits attached hereto and referenced herein, do hereby find:

1. I have jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter herein;
2. On March 17, 2021, Respondent entered into an [REDACTED] [REDACTED] with the Department after information came to the Department's attention regarding Respondent's [REDACTED] [REDACTED] [REDACTED]
3. As a condition of the [REDACTED] Respondent agreed to abstain from the consumption of alcohol. [REDACTED]
4. As a condition of the [REDACTED], Respondent agreed to submit to any drug screens requested pursuant to the [REDACTED] that Test results were to be reported

quarterly to the Department, and that any positive result was to be reported immediately to the Department. [REDACTED]

5. As a condition of the [REDACTED] Respondent agreed to the following:

Respondent agrees that if the Respondent violates any condition in this Agreement, the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation may issue an Order forthwith mandating the automatic, immediate and indefinite suspension of Respondent's Illinois Physician and Surgeon License for a minimum of twelve (12) months. This indefinite suspension shall not preclude the Department from taking any other disciplinary or other actions it deems appropriate. In the event Respondent contests in writing (by the filing of an appropriate petition with the Department) the factual basis underlying said indefinite suspension within fifteen (15) days of the imposition thereof, then Respondent shall be afforded a hearing on the merits within thirty (30) days from filing of said petition.

6. On January 10, 2022, [REDACTED] submitted a report stating Respondent tested positive for alcohol on a breathalyzer test. On April 18, 2022, [REDACTED] submitted a report stating Respondent acknowledged consuming alcohol on April 17, 2022.

7. Shami Goyal, M.D., Chief Medical Coordinator of the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, Division of Professional Regulation, reviewed the file of Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of [REDACTED] in the Case No. 2016-02522 and concluded that Respondent tested positive for alcohol consumption and acknowledged consumption of alcohol on two occasions, January 9, 2022, and April 17, 2022. A copy of the Affidavit of Shami Goyal, M.D., is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein as Dept. Exhibit 2.

Now therefore, I, Director Cecilia Abundis, do hereby find Respondent is in violation of the [REDACTED]. It is therefore Ordered that Respondent's Illinois Physician and Surgeon License, no. 036.075632, is Indefinitely Suspended for a minimum period of twelve (12) months.
