ORDER

This matter coming before the Director of the Division of Professional Regulation of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois on the Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew Physician and Surgeon License of Respondent, Rehana Aziz, M.D. (hereafter "Respondent"), filed by the DIVISION OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the State of Illinois, all due and proper notice having been served, Respondent having failed to file any request for a hearing and being duly advised in the premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DANIEL KELBER, THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL AND PROFESSIONAL REGULATION of the State of Illinois, hereby find:

1. THAT Respondent holds a Physician and Surgeon License in the State of Illinois, bearing license No. 036.087363, and said License is presently in NOT RENEWED status.
2. THAT the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois (Department) received information that the Medical Board of California ordered that Respondent's California Physician and Surgeon Certificate be immediately suspended.

3. THAT the basis of the Medical Board of California's action was that Respondent's ability to practice medicine safely is impaired [REDACTED]
4. THAT the aforesaid conduct is grounds to refuse to renew Respondent's License as a Physician and Surgeon under 225 ILCS 60/22(A)(12).
5. THAT I have jurisdiction of the parties and subject matter pursuant to 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes Section 60/22(A), et seq.

IT IS ORDERED that Rehana Aziz, M.D.'s Physician and Surgeon License SHALL NOT BE RENEWED as of the date of this Order.

Notice of Intent to Refuse to Renew

To: Rehana Aziz, M.D.


BE NOTIFIED that the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation of the State of Illinois (Department) has received information that your Physician and Surgeon License was disciplined by the State of California. The Department has jurisdiction to investigate this discipline and bring this action pursuant to the Medical Practice Act, 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 60/36.

BE NOTIFIED THAT failure to report to the Department an adverse action of another state or jurisdiction against a license to practice as a medical doctor constitutes a violation of the Medical Practice Act, 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 60/22 (A) paragraph 12. Additionally, a Sister-State Discipline is a violation of the Medical Practice Act, 225 Illinois Compiled Statutes, Section 60/22 (A) paragraph 34, and the Department has determined that your license to practice as a physician and surgeon in the State of Illinois may be placed on Refuse to Renew status or otherwise disciplined due to the Sister-State Discipline:

1. STATE OF DISCIPLINE: California
2. DATE OF DISCIPLINE: June 27, 2016
3. ACTION OF SISTER STATE: The Medical Board of California ("Board") ordered that Respondent's California Physician and Surgeon Certificate be immediately suspended.
4. BASIS OF SISTER STATE DISCIPLINE: Respondent is unable to practice medicine safely due to violations of the Medical Practice Act.

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that you have the right to request a hearing to address the issues that give rise to placing your Physician and Surgeon License in Refuse to Renew status. You shall have 30 days from the date of this notice to make a written request for a hearing. Failure to request a hearing within 30 days will result in the entry of the Order of Refusal to Renew your

Physician and Surgeon License. Your request for a hearing should be directed to the Clerk of the Court, Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, 100 W. Randolph St., Suite 9-300, Chicago, IL 60601

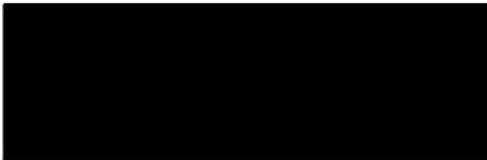
