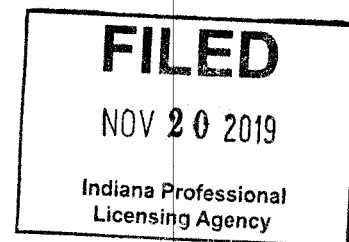

NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER

A final hearing was scheduled to be held on September 26, 2019, in Room W064 of the Indiana Government Center South, 402 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, to address the issues raised in the Complaint filed by the State on August 19, 2019, against the Indiana physician license of Suresh Kodali, M.D. (“Respondent”).

The State of Indiana was represented by Ryan P. Eldridge, Deputy Attorney General. Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel.

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-24, the Medical Licensing Board of Indiana (“Board”) issues this Notice of Proposed Default on the following grounds:

1. Respondent’s address on file with the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (“IPLA”) is 708 West Port Road, Suite 103, Elizabethtown, KY 42701.
2. Another known address for Respondent is 11617 Walnut View Way, Louisville, KY 40299.
3. On August 21, 2019, IPLA sent notice to Respondent at his listed address on file with IPLA, informing Respondent of the date, time and place of the final hearing.
4. On September 26, 2019, Respondent failed to appear in person or by counsel for the administrative hearing.

5. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-20, Respondent was provided adequate notice of the final hearing and failed to appear for said hearing.

ORDER

For Respondent's failure to appear for the final hearing, the Board issues the following Notice of Proposed Default Order:

In accordance with Indiana Code §4-21.5-3-24, Respondent must file a written motion within seven (7) days of service of this Order requesting the Board not enter a default order in this case and stating the reasons relied upon for that request. Failure of the Respondent to file such a written motion within seven (7) days shall result in the issuance of a default order. If Respondent timely files a motion, the Board shall consider said motion along with any relevant facts in determining whether a default order should be entered. Should a default order be entered against Respondent, the Board may hold further proceedings it deems appropriate to complete this case without the participation of Respondent.
