STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT ORDER

COME NOW, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") by and through Kelli J. Benintendi, Associate Counsel ("Petitioner"), and Vijendra Dave, M.D. ("Applicant") appearing *pro se*, and stipulate and agree to the following:

- 1. The Board is the sole and exclusive administration agency in the State of Kansas authorized to regulate the practice of the healing arts, specifically the practice of medicine and surgery. K.S.A 65-2801 et seq.; K.S.A. 65-2869.
- 2. Applicant admits that this Stipulation and Agreement and Enforcement Order ("Stipulation") and the filing of such document are in accordance with applicable law and that the Board has jurisdiction to consider the Stipulation.
- Applicant agrees that the Kansas Healing Arts Act is constitutional on its face and as applied in this case.
- 4. Applicant agrees that, in considering this matter, the Board is not acting beyond its jurisdiction as provided by law.
- 5. Applicant filed an application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas on or about August 24, 1999, and Applicant currently holds a postgraduate temporary permit, issued December 1, 1997.

- 7. According to K.S.A. 65-2838(b), the Board has authority to enter into this Stipulation without the necessity of proceeding to a formal hearing.
- 8. Applicant voluntarily and knowingly waives his right to a hearing. Applicant voluntarily and knowingly waives his right to present a defense by oral testimony and documentary evidence, to submit rebuttal evidence, and to conduct cross-examination of witnesses. Applicant voluntarily and knowingly agrees to waive all possible substantive and procedural motions and defenses that could be raised if an administrative hearing were held.
- 9. The terms and conditions of the Stipulation are entered into between the undersigned parties and are submitted for the purpose of allowing these terms and conditions to become an Order of the Board. This Stipulation shall not be binding on the Board until an authorized signature is affixed at the end of this document. Applicant specifically acknowledges that counsel for the Board is not authorized to sign this Stipulation on behalf of the Board.
- 10. In consideration of the conditions, terms, covenants, and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:
- (a) In lieu of the conclusion of formal proceedings and/or the making of findings by the Board, Applicant, by signature affixed to this Stipulation, hereby voluntarily agrees to the following limitations placed on his license to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas:

- (v) Applicant shall not engage in the solo practice of medicine and shall only practice in a group setting with ongoing supervision by a licensed physician approved by the Board, or its designee. Applicant is responsible for proposing to the Board a supervising physician to serve in that capacity.
- (vi) The supervising physician must submit quarterly reports regarding whether Applicant is practicing medicine with reasonable skill and safety, and whether Applicant's conduct and behavior is appropriate with patients and staff. Such reports shall be submitted to the Board, to the attention of Kelli J. Benintendi, by the 15th of the month at the end of each quarter. Failure of the supervising physician to submit the monitoring reports shall constitute a violation of the terms of this Stipulation and shall be grounds for disciplinary action. The supervising physician shall immediately notify the Board in writing if applicant is unable to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.
- (vii) Applicant shall immediately notify the Board of all changes in employment or (Confidential)

- (x) Applicant must obtain prior Board approval before modifying or discontinuing any of the requirements of this Stipulation.
- (b) This Order constitutes limitations on Applicant's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. These limitations shall remain in effect for at least five (5) years. At the end of five (5) years, Applicant may request the termination of the limitation.
- (c) Applicant's failure to comply with the provisions of the Stipulation will result in the Board taking disciplinary action as the Board deems appropriate according to the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act.
- (d) Nothing in this Stipulation shall be construed to deny the Board jurisdiction to investigate alleged violations of the Healing Arts Act, or to investigate complaints received under the Risk Management Law, K.S.A. 65-4921 *et seq.*, that are known or unknown and are not covered under this Stipulation, or to initiate formal proceedings based upon known or unknown allegations of violations of the Healing Arts Act.

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- (e) Applicant hereby releases the Board, its employees and agents, from any and all claims, including but not limited to, those damages, actions, liabilities and causes of action, both administrative and civil, including the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 et seq. This release shall forever discharge the Board of any and all claims or demands of every kind and nature that Applicant has claimed to have had at the time of this release or might have had, either known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, and Applicant shall not commence to prosecute, cause or permit to be prosecuted, any action or proceeding of any description against the Board, its employees or agents, arising out of acts leading to the execution of this Stipulation or the content of this Stipulation.
- (f) Applicant further understands and agrees that upon signature by Applicant, this document shall be deemed a public record, and shall be reported to the National Practitioner Databank, Federation of State Medical Boards, and any other reporting entities requiring disclosure of this Stipulation.
- (g) This Stipulation, when signed by both parties, constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may only be modified or amended by a subsequent document executed in the same manner by the parties.
- (h) Applicant agrees that all information maintained by the Board pertaining to the nature and result of any complaint and/or investigation may be fully disclosed to and considered by the Board in conjunction with the presentation of any offer of settlement, even if Applicant is not present. Applicant further acknowledges that the Board may conduct further inquiry as it deems necessary before the complete or partial acceptance or rejection of any offer of settlement.
- (i) Applicant, by signature to this document, waives any objection to the participation of the Board members in the consideration of this offer of settlement and agrees not to seek the

disqualification or recusal of any Board member in any future proceeding on the basis that the Board

member has received investigative information from any source which otherwise may not be

admissible or admitted as evidence.

(i) Applicant acknowledges that he has read this Stipulation and fully understands the

contents.

(k) Applicant acknowledges that this Stipulation has been entered into freely and

voluntarily.

(1) All correspondence or communication between Applicant and the Board relating to

this Stipulation shall be by certified mail addressed to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, Attn:

(m) Applicant shall obey all federal, state and local laws and rules governing the practice



FINAL ORDER (Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-501 et seq.)

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") by K.S.A. 65-2801 et seq. and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 et seq., the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. Members of the Board serving on the Disciplinary Panel for this matter were recused from participation.

I. Findings of Fact

The Board has been shown the following facts:

- 1. Vijendra Dave, M.D. ("Licensee"). (confidential) Wichita, KS 67216, is licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, License No. 04-28553, and has been so licensed since February 12, 2000.
- 2. On or about August 24, 1999, Licensee submitted an application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in Kansas. (confidential)

The public policy of regulating the practice of healing arts in the State of Kansas is set forth in K.S.A. 65-2801:

Recognizing that the practice of the healing arts is a privilege granted by legislative authority and is not a natural right of individuals, it is deemed necessary as a matter of policy in the interests of public health, safety and welfare, to provide laws and provisions covering the granting of that privilege and its subsequent use, control and regulation to the end that the public shall be properly protected against unprofessional, improper, unauthorized and unqualified practice of the healing arts and from unprofessional conduct by persons licensed to practice under this act.

IV. Conclusions of Law

Based upon the Findings of Fact enumerated in Paragraphs #1 through #16, the Applicable Law and the Policy Statement set forth above:

THE BOARD HEREBY CONCLUDES AS FOLLOWS:
