On February 14, 2006, the Board issued an **ORDER FOR SUMMARY SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE MEDICINE** in this case. Dr. Herschler was given an opportunity to attend a hearing on that issue on February 22, 2006. Dr. Herschler requested a postponement of that hearing, and the hearing was rescheduled for March 22, 2006. Dr. Herschler attended the rescheduled hearing on that date together with his counsel, Kevin A. Dunne, Esquire. The State was represented by Roger Picker, Esquire, and Janet Brown, Esquire, Administrative Prosecutors.


After considering the presentations at the hearing, including Dr. Herschler's Exhibits 1 and 2, the Board determined that it would not lift the summary suspension imposed on February 14, 2006. The Board concluded that the additional evidence, the arguments submitted and the responses to the Board's questions did not significantly change the Board's findings or conclusions regarding the danger to the public which would be posed by Dr. Herschler



practicing medicine at this time. Dr. Herschler was advised of this orally on the hearing date. Dr. Herschler was also advised of his rights to a full evidentiary hearing and in fact already requested a hearing prior to the date of this order.

This letter constitutes an order of the Board resulting from formal disciplinary action and is therefore a public document.
