IT IS FOUND that the facts alleged in the Complaint are true and

constitute violations of sections 16221(b)(x) and 16221(f) of the Public Health Code,

supra.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that for the cited violations of the Public Health Code,

Respondent is FINED \$250.00 to be paid to the State of Michigan within 30 days of the

effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the fine shall be mailed to the

Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Regulatory and Compliance

Division, Sanction Monitoring, P.O. Box 30189, Lansing, MI 48909. The fine shall

be paid by check or money order, made payable to the State of Michigan, and the check

or money order shall clearly display file number 43-15-137784.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent violates any

provision of this Order, the Disciplinary Subcommittee may proceed to take disciplinary

action pursuant to Mich Admin Code, R 338.1632 and section 16221(h) of the Public

Health Code, supra.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be effective 30

days from the date signed by the Disciplinary Subcommittee, as set forth below.

STIPULATION

- 1. The facts alleged in the Complaint are true and constitute a violation of sections 16221(b)(x) and 16221(f) of the Public Health Code, <u>supra</u>.
- 2. Respondent understands and intends that by signing this Stipulation Respondent is waiving the right, pursuant to the Public Health Code, the rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, as amended; MCL 24.201 et seq, to require the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Department) to prove the charges set forth in the Complaint by presentation of evidence and legal authority, and Respondent is waiving the right to appear with an attorney and such witnesses as Respondent may desire to present a defense to the charges.
- 3. Respondent and the Department further agree that this matter is a public record required to be published and made available to the public pursuant to section 11(1)(a) of the Michigan Freedom of Information Act, 1976 PA 442, as amended; MCL 15.241(1)(a); and this action will be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, and any other entity as required by state or federal law, in accordance with 42 USC 11101-11152.
- 4. Richard Burney, M.D., a member of the Michigan Board of Medicine who supports this proposal, and the Department's representative are both free to discuss this matter with the Disciplinary Subcommittee and recommend acceptance of the resolution set forth in this Order.

- This Order is approved as to form and substance by Respondent and the Department and may be entered as the final order of the Disciplinary Subcommittee in this matter.
- 6. This proposal is conditioned upon acceptance by the Disciplinary Subcommittee, Respondent and the Department expressly reserving the right to further proceedings without prejudice should the Order be rejected.
