FINAL ORDER

On March 15, 2017, the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Department) executed an Administrative Complaint charging Respondent with violating the Public Health Code, MCL 333.1101 *et seq*.

The Complaint notified Respondent that, pursuant to MCL 333.16231, Respondent's failure to respond to the Complaint within 30 days from the date of receipt would be treated as an admission of the allegations contained in the Complaint and would result in transmittal of the Complaint directly to the Michigan Board of Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery Disciplinary Subcommittee (DSC) for imposition of an appropriate sanction.

Contrary to MCL 333.16231, Respondent failed to provide a written response to the allegations set forth in the Complaint within 30 days from the date of receipt.

The DSC, having read the Complaint, considered this matter at a regularly scheduled meeting held in Lansing, Michigan on August 3, 2017, and imposed a sanction

Final Order File No. 51-17-145382 pursuant to MCL 333.16231. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that for violating MCL 333.16221(h), Respondent's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery is SUSPENDED for a minimum of one day commencing on the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension on Respondent's license shall be automatically reinstated IF WITHIN SIX MONTHS FROM THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDER the Respondent successfully completes and provides to the Department satisfactory written evidence of successful completion of a total of 150 hours of Board-accepted continuing education, which includes 60 hours in category one or category three, and has paid the fine as set forth below. The 150 hours shall not apply in computing Respondent's current continuing education requirements for license renewal. Respondent shall mail evidence of successful completion of the continuing education to the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Enforcement Division, Compliance Section, P.O. Box 30670, Lansing, MI 48909.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent's license to practice remains suspended for more than six months, Respondent must apply for reinstatement of the license. In the event Respondent applies for reinstatement of the license, application for reinstatement shall be in accordance with MCL 333.16245 and 333.16247.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event Respondent's license to practice expires or is expired during the period of suspension, Respondent must apply for relicensure, in accordance with MCL 333.16201.

Final Order File No. 51-17-145382 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent is FINED \$2,000.00, to be

paid to the State of Michigan prior to the reinstatement of Respondent's license.

Respondent shall direct payment to the Department of Licensing and Regulatory

Affairs, Enforcement Division, Compliance Section, P.O. Box 30189, Lansing, MI

48909. The fine shall be paid by check or money order, made payable to the State of

Michigan, and shall clearly display file number 51-17-145382.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order replaces the previous Consent

Order and Stipulation dated December 5, 2014.

and this action may be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank, and any other

entity as required by state or federal law, in accordance with 42 USC 11101-11152.
