(The identity of patient "D" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

5. During a period of time in 1985, 1986, 1987 and 1988, you engaged in unprofessional and/or immoral conduct of a sexual nature with a female, identified to you as patient "E," during a period of time when she was rendered professional services and advice by you. (The identity of patient "E" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

The above allegations, if proven, would constitute grounds, under N.C.G.S. Sec. 90-14(a)(1) and (6), for the suspension or revocation of the license to practice medicine issued to you by the undersigned Board.

You are further given notice that you will be given an opportunity to appear before the Board in person and by counsel in a hearing concerning the foregoing charges and allegations on the 5th day of May, 1989, at one o'clock, p.m. at the North Raleigh Hilton, 3415 Old Wake Forest Road, Raleigh, North Carolina, at which time you may present evidence in your behalf. In the meantime, you may file, within thirty (30) days, a written response to the foregoing charges if you so desire.

OBJECTIONS, EXCEPTIONS
AND NOTICE OF APPEAL

PURSUANT TO N.C.G.S. §90-14.8, Barry Allen Moore, M.D., makes the following particularized objections and exceptions to the FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER of the "Board of Medical Examiners" entered on August 28, 1989 and communicated to the Respondent, Barry Allen Moore, on September 1, 1989 and gives Notice of Appeal to the General Court of Justice, Superior Court Division, in Wake County, N.C.

The particularized objections and exceptions of the Respondent, Barry Allen Moore, M.D., are as follows:

1. The hearing before the Board was not conducted in accordance with the statutory procedures established by N.C.G.S. §90-14.2;

2. The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina consists of eight members; the "Board" which conducted the hearing in this matter consisted of only five persons;

3. The "Board" issued its decision in this matter before the record was complete in that there had been a Stipulation by counsel for the parties that the record would be supplemented

with a written Stipulation regarding the testimony of four physicians speaking on behalf of the Respondent and that the "Board" would consider the evidence received in that manner as fully as though given by the witnesses, under oath, at the proceeding before the "Board"; yet, the "Board" issued its decision before the written Stipulation regarding that testimony ever was received and therefore such testimony could not have been considered by the "Board" as agreed;

4. Findings of Fact 7, 8, 12, 13, 16, 17, 20, 21, 24 and 26 are not supported by competent, material and substantial evidence;

5. The "Board" has penalized the Respondent, Barry Allen Moore, M.D., on charge 3 even though the allegations comprising that charge were not proven;

6. Conclusions of Law 2, 3, 4 and 5 are not supported by competent, material and substantial evidence and are arbitrary and capricious; and

7. On information and belief, the "Board" went outside the testimony presented at the hearing and considered information from sources other than witnesses and thereby deprived Respondent of his constitutional right to confront his accusers under the constitutions of North Carolina and the United States.



This matter is before the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina (hereinafter Board) regarding Barry Allen Moore, M.D. (hereinafter Dr. Moore).

Whereas Dr. Moore has met with the Board to discuss personal matters regarding his history of problems concerning sexual exploitation of his patients, and

Whereas the Board previously revoked Dr. Moore's license to practice medicine for having intimate or sexual relationships with patients, and

Whereas, in September, 1991, the Board gave Dr. Moore a temporary license to practice medicine, and he has practiced medicine since then without similar adverse incident coming to the attention of the Board,

Whereas Dr. Moore is prepared to take further steps to assure the Board and the people of North Carolina that he can safely practice medicine, and

Whereas Dr. Moore desires to resolve this matter without need for more formal proceedings, and

Whereas the Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this matter as set forth below;

Now, therefore, with Dr. Moore' consent, it is ORDERED that:

1. Dr. Moore be issued a license to practice medicine in North Carolina by the Board to expire at the end of the day on September 30, 1996.

2. Dr. Moore shall have a chaperon present whenever he examines or treats a female patient.

3. Dr. Moore shall appear before the Board for an informal interview at the Board's September, 1996, meeting, and at such other times requested by the Board.

4. Dr. Moore shall notify the Board of any address change within ten (10) days of the change.

5. Dr. Moore shall obey all laws.

6. If Dr. Moore fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct and shall be grounds, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6), after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to restrict, deny, annul, suspend, or revoke his license to practice medicine.

7. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Moore and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.

8. Dr. Moore hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Consent Order be served on him.

9. Upon execution by Dr. Moore and the Board, this Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to

public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof.

You are hereby given notice that the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of North Carolina ("Board") has preferred and does hereby prefer against you the following charges and allegations:

1. During a period of time beginning on or about March 1, 1987 through on or about April 30, 1987, you engaged in unprofessional conduct in that you performed unchaperoned physical examinations of the breasts of patient "A." (The identity of patient "A" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

2. During a period of time in 1984 and 1985, you engaged in unprofessional and/or immoral conduct of a sexual nature with a female, identified to you as patient "B," during a period of time when she was rendered professional services and advice by you. (The identity of patient "B" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

3. During a period of time beginning on or about December 1986 through on or about July 1987, you engaged in unprofessional and/or immoral conduct of a sexual nature with a female, identified to you as patient "C," after a period of time when she was rendered professional services and advice by you and at such time as you knew that she was under treatment by another therapist, and at a time when you knew or should have known that such unprofessional sexual conduct may cause an aggravation of the mental and marital status of patient "C." (The identity of patient "C" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

4. During a period of time beginning on or about January 1988 and ending on or about May 1988, you engaged in unprofessional and/or immoral conduct of a sexual nature with a female, identified to you as patient "D," during a period of time when she was rendered professional services and advice by you. (The identity of patient "D" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

5. During a period of time in 1985, 1986, 1987 and 1988, you engaged in unprofessional and/or immoral conduct of a sexual nature with a female, identified to you as patient "E," during a period of time when she was rendered professional services and advice by you. (The identity of patient "E" has been disguised to protect patient privacy. The name of the patient will be disclosed to you upon your written request.)

The above allegations, if proven, would constitute grounds, under N.C.G.S. Sec. 90-14(a)(1) and (6), for the suspension or revocation of the license to practice medicine issued to you by the undersigned Board.

You are further given notice that you will be given an opportunity to appear before the Board in person and by counsel in a hearing concerning the foregoing charges and allegations on the 5th day of May, 1989, at one o'clock, p.m. at the North Raleigh Hilton, 3415 Old Wake Forest Road, Raleigh, North Carolina, at which time you may present evidence in your behalf. In the meantime, you may file, within thirty (30) days, a written response to the foregoing charges if you so desire.
