This matter is before the North Carolina Medical Board ("Board") regarding information provided to the Board concerning Justin Luke Gettings, M.D. ("Dr. Gettings"). Dr. Gettings makes the following admissions and the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

STATUTORY AUTHORITY

The Board is a body duly organized under the laws of North Carolina and is the proper party to bring this proceeding under the authority granted to it in Article 1 of Chapter 90 of the North Carolina General Statutes and the rules and regulations promulgated thereto.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Dr. Gettings is a physician licensed by the Board on or about February 13, 2017, license number 2017-00229.

In May 2015, Dr. Gettings was issued a resident training license by the Board via Consent Order ("2015 Consent Order") that contained a stayed indefinite suspension.

Prior to being issued his resident training license, Dr. Gettings had been assessed by the North Carolina Physicians Health Program ("NCPHP") and entered into a five-year monitoring contract with NCPHP. NCPHP advocated for the issuance of his resident training license.

On February 13, 2017, the Board and Dr. Gettings entered into an Amended Consent Order ("2017 Amended Consent Order") which issued Dr. Gettings a full medical license but limited Dr. Gettings's medical practice to practice locations that were approved by his residency program.

Dr. Gettings has requested that the worksite restrictions in his 2017 Amended Consent Order be terminated.

Dr. Gettings has complied with the terms and conditions of his 2015 Consent Order and 2017 Amended Consent Order.

PROCEDURAL STIPULATIONS

Dr. Gettings acknowledges and agrees that the Board has jurisdiction over him and over the subject matter of this case.

Dr. Gettings knowingly waives his right to any hearing and to any judicial review or appeal in this case.

Dr. Gettings acknowledges that he has read and understands this Second Amended Consent Order and enters into it voluntarily.

The Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this case as set forth below.

ORDER

Now, therefore, with Dr. Gettings's consent, it is ORDERED that:

- 1. Dr. Gettings is hereby relieved of enumerated paragraph 1 of his 2017 Amended Consent Order restricting his practice of medicine to his residency program and those practice locations approved by his residency program. Dr. Gettings hereby has a full and unrestricted license to practice medicine in North Carolina.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the 2017 Amended Consent Order remain in effect.
- 3. Dr. Gettings shall obey all laws. Likewise, he shall obey all rules and regulations involving the practice of medicine.
- 4. Dr. Gettings shall meet with the Board or members of the Board for an investigative interview at such times as requested by the Board.
- 5. Upon request, Dr. Gettings shall provide the Board with any information the Board deems necessary to verify compliance with the terms and conditions of this Second Amended Consent Order.
- 6. If Dr. Gettings fails to comply with any of the terms of this Second Amended Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C.

- Gen. Stat. § 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend, or revoke his license and to deny any application he might make in the future or then have pending for a license.
- 7. This Second Amended Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Gettings and the Board and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.
- 8. Dr. Gettings hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Second Amended Consent Order be served on him.
- 9. Upon execution by Dr. Gettings and the Board, this Second Amended Consent Order shall become a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and shall be subject to public inspection and dissemination pursuant to the provisions thereof. Additionally, it will be reported to persons, entities, agencies, and clearinghouses as required and permitted by law including, but not limited to, the Federation of State Medical Boards and the National Practitioner Data Bank.
