Dear Dr. McCauley:

The North Carolina Medical Board ("NC Board") has concluded its investigation related to the action taken against your West Virginia medical license by the West Virginia Board of Medicine ("WV Board"). As a result, the NC Board voted to issue you this public letter of concern. The NC Board does not consider a public letter of concern to be a disciplinary action or a limitation or restriction on your NC medical license.

The Board is concerned that on November 8, 2018, you entered into a Consent Order with the WV Board requiring you to satisfy a continuing medical education ("CME") deficiency for the reporting period of July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2017, by completing forty-four (44) hours of CME. This action was based on findings by the WV Board that you certified on your June 19, 2017, renewal application to the WV Board that you had complied with all the CME requirements to renew your WV license. However, after being randomly selected for an annual CME audit, it was discovered that you had not completed all required CME.

The NC Board urges you to take steps to ensure the conduct giving rise to the NC Board's concern does not happen again. Otherwise, the NC Board may vote to commence formal disciplinary proceedings against your NC medical license. If that happens, this letter may be entered into evidence in determining the appropriate discipline.

This public letter of concern is a public record within the meaning of Chapter 132 of the North Carolina General Statutes and is subject to public inspection and dissemination as required by that law. It will be reported to the Federation of State Medical Boards. It will not be reported to the National Practitioner Data Bank.
