Stat. § 90-14(a)(5), and grounds exist under that section of the General Statutes for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, or limit his license to practice medicine and surgery or to deny any application he might make in the future, and

Whereas the Board has determined that it is in the public interest to resolve this case as set forth below:

Now, therefore, with Dr. Weed's consent, it is ORDERED that:

- 1. Dr. Weed's license to practice medicine and surgery is hereby reinstated subject to the following conditions, and said license will expire on the date shown thereon.
 - a. Dr. Weed agrees to abide by all laws, rules and regulation in the future.

- b. Dr. Weed shall maintain his contract with NCPHP and abide by its terms, including the timely payment of any fees required by NCPHP.
- c. Upon request by the Board, Dr. Weed shall supply urine, blood, hair, or any other bodily fluid or tissue sample the Board might reasonably require for the purposes of analysis to determine if he has consumed any of the substances mentioned above. All costs of obtaining and analyzing such samples shall be borne by Dr. Weed.
- d. Dr. Weed shall provide a copy of this Consent Order to all current and prospective employers.
- e. Unless lawfully prescribed for him by someone other than himself, Dr. Weed shall refrain from the use or possession of all mind- or mood-altering substances and all controlled substances including but not limited to, sedatives, stimulants, pain medications.
- f. Dr. Weed shall notify the Board in writing within ten (10) days of his use of such medication. This notice shall include, but shall not be limited to, identification of the prescribing physician and of the pharmacy filling the prescription.

- g. Dr. Weed shall notify the Board in writing of any change in his residence or practice addresses within ten (10) days of the change.
- 2. If Dr. Weed fails to comply with any of the terms of this Consent Order, that failure shall constitute unprofessional conduct within the meaning of N.C. Gen. Stat. 90-14(a)(6) and shall be grounds, after any required notice and hearing, for the Board to annul, suspend, revoke, condition, or limit Dr. Weed's license to practice medicine or to deny any application he might make in the future or then have pending for a license.
- 3. Dr. Weed shall meet with the Board or members of the Board for an informal interview at such times as requested by the Board.
- 4. This Consent Order shall take effect immediately upon its execution by both Dr. Weed and the Board, and it shall continue in effect until specifically ordered otherwise by the Board.
- 5. Dr. Weed hereby waives any requirement under any law or rule that this Consent Order be served on him.
