ORDER MODIFYING CONSENT ORDER DATED DECEMBER 14, 2016

Now before the Board is a request by Greg Thompson, M.D. ("Dr. Thompson"), to modify his Consent Order of December 14, 2016. Specifically, Dr. Thompson requests that the Board modify section 8(D) of the Consent Order which currently restricts his prescribing practices. Dr. Thompson would like to return to treating general psychiatric patients, and doing psychiatric intakes with the general public who may not have Substance Use Disorders. Dr. Thompson is also requesting a date in which the monthly supervision with Malcolm S. Beaudett, M.D. with quarterly reports will end. After review of the reasons for this request, and after reviewing Dr. Beaudett's letter of March 23, 2019, indicating he agrees with this request, the Board approves Dr. Thompson's request.


THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the Board approves Dr. Thompson's request to modify his Consent Order dated December 14, 2016, section 8D, to allow his return to treating general psychiatric patients, and doing psychiatric intakes with the general public who may not have Substance Use Disorders. Section 8D of the Consent Order is hereby amended to read as follows: "Upon returning to practice, Respondent's license shall be restricted to the practice of general psychiatry and addiction treatment utilizing medication assisted treatment."; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Thompson will continue with his Monitor, Malcolm S. Beaudett, M.D., as described in the Consent Order of December 14, 2016, for two (2) years from the date he begins his general psychiatric practice. Dr. Thompson shall notify the Board when he begins treating general psychiatric patients.
