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The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Michael David Thein, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

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The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

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In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

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- 3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the clinical practice of medicine and his license is placed in an Administrative Medicine status until December 23, 2011 at 4:00 PM at which point Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and his license is placed in an Inactive Status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into his ability to safely and competently practice medicine.
- 3.2 Licensec understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for

1 disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17). Licensee must notify the Oregon Medical Board within 10 days of December 23, 2 3.3 2011 as to how patients may access or obtain their medical records. 3 4 At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an 5 expeditious manner. Following that review, if the Board determines that Licensee shall not be 6 permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that 7 8 decision. 9 5, This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265(1) and (2) for the purpose 10 of protecting the public, and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with 11 respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and 12 competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are 13 14 confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure, nor shall they be admissible as evidence in any judicial proceeding. 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



7	which he voluntarily withdrew from the practice of medicine.

19	Licensee and the Board agree to close this investigation with this Stipulated Order in
20	which Licensee agrees to surrender his license while under investigation, consistent with the
21	terms of this Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing
22	under the Administrative Procedures Act (chapter 183), Oregon Revised Statutes and fully
23	and finally waives the right to a contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the
24	signing of and entry of this Order in the Board's records. Licensee and the Board
25	acknowledge that this Order will terminate the Amended Interim Stipulated Order, dated
26	December 23, 2011. By entering into this Order, Licensee understands that although the
