The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain health care providers, including physicians, in the State of Oregon. Anthony Salvatore Cull, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the State of Oregon.

2.

On January 3, 2020, the Board issued a Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary Action (Notice) in which the Board proposed to take disciplinary action by imposing up to the maximum range of potential sanctions identified in ORS 677.205(2), which may include the revocation of license, a \$10,000 civil penalty per violation, and assessment of costs, pursuant to ORS 677.205 against Licensee for violations of the Medical Practice Act, to wit: ORS 677.190(1)(a) unprofessional or dishonorable conduct, as defined in ORS 677.188(4)(a) any conduct or practice contrary to recognized standards of ethics of the medical profession or any conduct or practice which does or might constitute a danger to the health or safety of a patient or the public; ORS 677.190(4) obtaining any fee by fraud or misrepresentation; and ORS 677.190(13) gross or repeated acts of negligence. Prior to the issuance of the Notice, on May 24, 2019, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order with the Board in which he agreed to voluntarily withdraw from practice pending the completion of the Board's investigation.

Licensee and the Board desire to settle this matter by the entry of this Stipulated Order. Licensee understands that he has the right to a contested case hearing under the Administrative

1 Procedures Act (Oregon Revised Statutes chapter 183), and fully and finally waives the right to a
2 contested case hearing and any appeal therefrom by the signing of and entry of this Order in the
3 Board's records. Licensee neither admits nor denies, but the Board finds that Licensee engaged
4 in conduct as described in the January 3, 2020, Complaint and Notice of Proposed Disciplinary
5 Action, and that this conduct violated the Medical Practice Act, to wit 677.190(1)(a), as defined
6 in ORS 677.188(4)(a); ORS 677.190(4); and ORS 677.190(13). Licensee understands that this
7 Order is a public record and is a disciplinary action that is reportable to the National Practitioner
8 Data Bank and the Federation of State Medical Boards.

10 Licensee and the Board agree that the Board will close this investigation and resolve this
11 matter by entry of this Stipulated Order, subject to the following conditions:

12 4.1 Licensee surrenders his Oregon medical license while under investigation.

13 4.2 Licensee is reprimanded.

14 4.3 Licensee must pay a civil penalty of \$5,000. Two thousand, five hundred dollars
15 of this civil penalty is due within six months from the effective date of this Order; the remaining
16 \$2,500 is held in abeyance as long as Licensee does not apply for a license to practice medicine
17 in the State of Oregon.

18 4.4 The May 24, 2019, Interim Stipulated Order terminates effective the date the
19 Board Chair signs this Stipulated Order.

20 4.5 Should Licensee wish to be relicensed in the State of Oregon, Licensee must
21 apply as a new applicant and meet all current licensing requirements, pursuant to ORS 677.100
22 and OAR 847-008-0051.

23 4.6 Licensee must obey all Federal and Oregon State laws and regulations pertaining
24 to the practice of medicine.

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
