
ORDER OF THE BOARD

On this the 2nd day of December, 1985, came on to be heard before the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners, duly in session, a request for cancellation of license filed with the Board on October 14, 1985, by Gerald I. Busch, M. D., of Houston, Harris County, Texas, who requested such licensure cancellation because of impaired health, and in lieu of any disciplinary hearing before the Board.
