ORDER

On the 24th day of February, 1998, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of Frank Stuart Murphy, D.O. ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on April 15, 1994 and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license J-3167.


Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives Penny Angelo, a member of the Board, and Buddy R. Sienbenlist, M.D., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on Petitioner's history of compliance with the terms and conditions of his April 15, 1994 Order, his record of rehabilitation, and his desire to re-enter and complete residency training, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be GRANTED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is GRANTED and the Order is hereby TERMINATED.
