ORDER

On the 22nd day of April, 1996, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of Herbert Allen Davis, M.D., ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on March 4, 1995, and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license, D-2408.

Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives Connie Navar-Clark, a member of the Board, and Allan David Axelrad, M.D., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.


Based on the information presented, the nature of the violation, and because Petitioner has served only one (1) year of his probationary term, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be DENIED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is DENIED.

All provisions of the March 4, 1995 Order remain in full force and effect until superseded by a subsequent Order of the Board.
