ORDER

On the 18th day of July, 1996, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of David Joel Korman, M.D., ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on August 8, 1995, and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license, G-5263.


Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives Charles W. Monday, Jr., M.D., a member of the Board, and Ann H. Nolen, D.O., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on the information presented, the nature of the violation, and the five year period of licensure restriction, of which only one year has been served, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be DENIED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is DENIED.
