ORDER

On the 13th day of August, 1997, came on to be heard before representatives of the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners ("the Board"), the petition of David J. Korman, M.D. ("Petitioner") requesting termination of a Board Order entered on August 19, 1995, and pertaining to Petitioner's Texas medical license G-5263.


Petitioner appeared in person, without counsel, before representatives Carlos Campos, M.D., a member of the Board, and Robert Bacon, M.D., a District Review Committee member. Information concerning the petition was considered and Petitioner argued for termination of the Order.

Based on changes which Petitioner has effected in his office practice, Petitioner's history of compliance with the terms and conditions of his August 19, 1995, Order, that there has been no recurrence of improper actions in the past seven (7) years, and upon recommendation of Petitioner's peers, the Board representatives recommend that the termination request be GRANTED.

Based on the available information and the recommendation of the Board representatives, the Board ORDERS that the Petition is GRANTED and the Order is hereby TERMINATED.
