Dear Dr. Dimock:

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, you are hereby given notice that your license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia has been mandatorily suspended by the enclosed Order entered February 20, 2018. You are hereby advised that you may not practice medicine and surgery or hold yourself out as a licensed physician and surgeon unless and until the Board of Medicine has notified you in writing that your license has been reinstated. Please return your license to William L. Harp, Executive Director of the Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board"), at the above address, immediately upon receipt of this letter.

You may apply to the Board for reinstatement of your license, and you shall be entitled to a formal administrative hearing not later than the next regular meeting of the Board after the expiration of 60 days from the Board's receipt of your reinstatement application. The reinstatement of your license shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the Board present at the hearing. ORDER OF MANDATORY SUSPENSION

In accordance with Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, I, David E. Brown, D.C., Director of the Virginia Department of Health Professions, received and acted upon evidence that the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, Canada, suspended the certificate of registration of John Leslie Dimock, M.D., to practice medicine in the Province of Ontario. A copy of the Notice of Suspension is attached hereto as Commonwealth's Exhibit 1.

WHEREUPON, by the authority vested in the Director of the Department of Health Professions pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, it is hereby ORDERED that the license of John Leslie Dimock, M.D., to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia is hereby SUSPENDED.

Upon entry of this Order, the license of John Leslie Dimock, M.D., will be recorded as suspended and no longer current and valid. Should Dr. Dimock seek reinstatement of his license pursuant to Virginia Code § 54.1-2409, he shall be responsible for any fees that may be required for the reinstatement of the license prior to issuance of the license to resume practice.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-4023 and § 54.1-2400.2, the signed original of this Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection or copying on request.

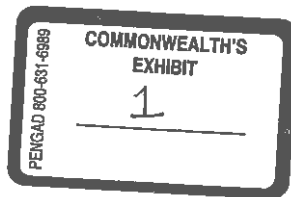

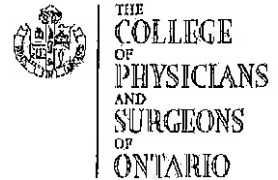

On January 10, 2018, the Discipline Committee found that Dr. Dimock has engaged in conduct or an act or acts relevant to the practice of medicine that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

On January 10, 2018 the Discipline Committee ordered and directed that:

1. Dr. Dimock appear before the panel to be reprimanded.
2. The Registrar suspend Dr. Dimock's certificate of registration for a period of four (4) months commencing on January 10, 2018.
3. The Registrar impose the following terms, conditions and limitations on Dr. Dimock's Certificate of Registration:
 - (i) Dr. Dimock will successfully complete, within six months of the date of this Order, a course in ethics and boundaries acceptable to the College (such as the PROBE course);
 - (ii) Dr. Dimock will successfully complete, within six months of the date of this Order, counselling in anger management or communication in difficult settings acceptable to the College; and
 - (iii) Dr. Dimock shall be responsible for any and all costs associated with implementing the terms of this Order.
4. Dr. Dimock pay costs to the College in the amount of \$5,500 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.


