RESCISSION OF STAY OF SUSPENSION

The Board of Medicine has received verification that you have been dismissed from the Virginia Health Practitioners' Monitoring Program.


In accordance with your Board of Medicine Consent Order entered July 31, 2017, the stay of indefinite suspension has been summarily rescinded. Your license to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia is **INDEFINITELY SUSPENDED** effective this date.

If you wish to contest this action, you may request a formal hearing before the Board. A request for a formal hearing on this matter must be in writing, addressed to the attention of Jennifer L. Deschenes, Deputy Executive Director, and received by the Board within 33 days from the date of this letter. Upon receipt of your timely, written request, a formal hearing will be scheduled. Please note that failure to request a formal hearing within 33 days will not prevent you from applying for reinstatement of your license at a later date.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400.2 of the *Code of Virginia*, a signed copy of this letter shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.
