CONSENT ORDER

The Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") and Keshavpal Gunna Reddy, M.D., as evidenced by their signatures affixed below, agree to enter into this Consent Order affecting the license of Dr. Reddy to practice medicine and surgery in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Board adopts the following findings and conclusions in this matter:

1. Keshavpal Gunna Reddy, M.D., was issued license number 0101-053228 by the Board to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Virginia on September 26, 1995. Said license is currently active and will expire on November 30, 2012, unless renewed or otherwise restricted.

2. Dr. Reddy violated Section 54.1-2915.A(5) of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended ("Code") in that by Consent Order of the North Carolina Medical Board dated August 23, 2010, Dr. Reddy was issued a reprimand and was prohibited from supervising any clinical pharmacist practitioner. This action was based on the finding that Dr. Reddy failed to provide supervision and evaluation of the drug therapy management provided to one patient by a clinical pharmacist practitioner under Dr. Reddy's supervision.

CONSENT

I, Keshavpal Gunna Reddy, M.D., by affixing my signature hereto, acknowledge that:

1. I have been advised specifically to seek the advice of counsel prior to signing this document;
2. I am fully aware that without my consent, no legal action can be taken against me, except pursuant to the Virginia Administrative Process Act, § 2.2-4000.A et seq. of the Code;
3. I have the following rights, among others:
 - a. the right to an informal conference before the Board;
 - b. the right to appear in person or by counsel, or other qualified representative before the agency; and
4. I waive all rights to an informal conference;
5. I admit the truth of the above Findings of Fact contained herein and agree not to contest the Findings of Fact or Conclusions of Law in any subsequent proceeding before the Board; and
6. I consent to the following Order affecting my license to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of the licensee, it is hereby ORDERED that NO SANCTION be imposed on the license of Keshavpal Gunna Reddy, M.D., since appropriate action has been taken by the North Carolina Medical Board.

Pursuant to Section 54.1-2400.2 of the Code, the signed original of this Consent Order shall remain in the custody of the Department of Health Professions as a public record and shall be made available for public inspection and copying upon request.

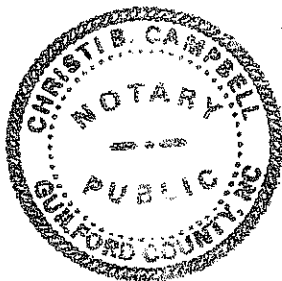
