
**STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE**

On July 31, 2014, John D. Muir, M.D. (Respondent), entered into a CONSENT DECREE approved by the Board. Respondent complied with all requirements placed on him through the CONSENT DECREE. On January 22, 2015, Petitioner and Respondent submitted a STIPULATED MOTION FOR CLOSURE OF DOCKET No. 15-01 (attached hereto and fully incorporated herein). The Board finds that it is appropriate to grant the relief requested in the Stipulation and close the matter in Docket No. 15-01.


**ORDER**

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**STIPULATED MOTION FOR CLOSURE OF DOCKET No. 15-01**

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COME NOW, Petitioners, Ms. Cissy Dillon, and Michael Jording, M.D., and Respondent, John D. Muir, M.D., (“Muir”), both through counsel, to stipulate the facts as follows, in requesting that the Wyoming Board of Medicine, (“Board”) accept the Stipulated Motion for Closure of Docket No. 15-01:

1. On July 31, 2014, Petitioners and Muir entered into a Consent Decree.
2. The Consent Decree was subject to the conditions as follows:
  - a. Respondent agrees and consents to a public reprimand of Respondent’s Wyoming physician license, beginning with the effective date of this Consent Decree;
  - b. Respondent shall attend and successfully complete a medical ethics course within six (6) months of the effective date of this Consent Decree; the course shall have a strong emphasis on maintaining appropriate physician/patient boundaries. Respondent shall submit a written request to Petitioners seeking preapproval in writing by Petitioners or their representative before attendance by Respondent;
  - c. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with attending and completing the course;

d. Respondent shall provide written evidence of attendance and completion of the course to the Board immediately upon completion of each;

e. Respondent shall pay partial costs incurred by the Board in this matter, in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), within sixty (60) days from the effective date of this Consent Decree;

f. Respondent shall personally meet with Petitioners and/or the Board, when and where requested, during the term of this Consent Decree or Board Order approving it;

g. Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws and all administrative rules governing physicians' practice of medicine in Wyoming;

h. Respondent shall be responsible for all costs of complying with this Consent Decree; and

i. If Respondent violates any provision, term or condition of this Consent Decree, the Board may take any further action against Respondent's Wyoming physician license deemed appropriate and allowed hereunder or by law.

3. On July 31, 2014, at a regularly-scheduled meeting of the Board, the Board hearing panel, consisting of Anne MacGuire, M.D.; David Skolnick, D.O.; Kristina Stefka, M.D.; and Donald Tardif, PA-C; heard evidence to support the Stipulate Motion for Acceptance of the Consent Decree.

4. On August 1, 2014, the Board entered an Order approving the Consent Decree.<sup>1</sup>

5. On August 22, 2014, Muir made payment to the Board in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), for partial costs in this matter.

6. On or about October 29, 2014, Notice of Compliance with Consent Decree was received by the Board office, with confirmation Muir attended the required course

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

THEREFORE, Petitioners and Respondent, respectfully request that the Board enter an Order approving the Stipulated Motion for Closure of Docket No. 15-01.


